(provisional) NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Dragon Class rules.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of FFVoile (French Federation of Sailing) will apply to foreign Competitors (rules 64.3, 68, 70.5, 86.3, 88.2,91 and appendix F) and are detailed in appendix 1 will be posted on the official notice board and are available on:

- 1.3 The Organising Authority may change the Notice of Race in accordance with RRS 89.2(a). Any such changes will be posted on the regatta website.
- 1.4 If there is a conflict in the translation between languages the French text will take precedence.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to ISAF Regulation 20.4.1.1.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display sponsors advertising supplied by the Organising Authority for the duration of the event.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 This regatta is open to the Dragon class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form with the required fee to:

- 3.3 Only Dragon class boats with a valid measurement certificate shall be authorized to race.
- 3.4 Foreign competitors without licenses in France must be members of their National Authority which is a member of ISAF.
- 3.5 Competitors resident in France must present at registration their license FFVoile with the medical certificate and official stamp stating no restrictions to race.

4 ENTRY FEE.

- 4.1 The fee is €350 before 15th August.
- 4.2 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: After this date the entry fee will be €400.
- 4.3 This includes craning in and out, marina berth for the duration of the Regatta, trailer storage and all receptions with the exception of the Dragon dinner.
- 4.4 Tickets for this dinner will be available at registration for an all inclusive cost of €30 pp.

5.2 The Race Committee reserve the right to schedule an extra race per day if necessary.

5.3 On the last day of racing September 12th no warning signal will be made after 14h00.

6 MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate. This will be checked during registration in accordance with Dragon class rules.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions will be available at registration on September 8th from 16h00-18h00 and on September 9th from 09h00 -13h00.

8 THE COURSES

The courses will be of windward leeward type.

9 RACING AREA

Races will be held in the Bay of Quiberon.

10 SCORING

10.1 A maximum of six (6) races will be sailed. Three (3) races are required to constitute a series.

10.2 When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.3 When from 5 or 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

11 BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places on the marina.

12 HAUL OUT RESTRICTONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

13 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus, including snorkels and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used below the waterline between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

14 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats. This restriction applies to mobile telephones.

15 PRIZES

Prizes will be presented as follows:

- 15.1 Prizes will be presented to the first three boats overall.
- 15.2 Daily prizes will be presented to the individual race winners.
- 15.3 A prize will be presented to the first Classic Boat.
- 15.4 Other prizes may be presented.

16 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to race. The organizing authority will not except any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to during or after the regatta.

17 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1.5 million Euros per incident or the equivalent.
